## Scope and Sequence of the Lessons:

### – Lesson One: Decide Now to Stand Strong

#### *Study of Daniel 1*

*Theme Verse:* “...Daniel was determined not to *violate God’s law and* defile himself...” (1:8 VOICE)

#### *Outline:*

- Daniel Made Up His Mind Before...
- Daniel Lived a Disciplined Life (Physically, Mentally and Spiritually)

### – Lesson Two: Do I Really Wanna’ Be Guilty?

#### *Study of Daniel 3*

*Theme Verse:* “...the God we serve is able to rescue us... and release us from your power... But even if He does not, O king, you can be sure that we *still* will not serve your gods...” (3:17-18 VOICE)

#### *Outline:*

- The characters, the setting, the plot, the conflict, and the resolution.
- Who’s writing the script for my life?

### – Lesson Three: What Will It Take to Get My Attention?

#### *Study of Daniel 4 & 5*

*Theme Verse:* “...please accept my advice to you. Make a *clean* break with your sins and invest in what is right. Bring an end to your wicked deeds and show mercy to those you have beaten down.” (4:27 VOICE)

#### *Outline:*

- God Is In Control of Everything and Everyone
- God Speaks Truth Into Our Lives
- We Can Change (like Nebuchadnezzar) or Not (like Belshazzar)—It’s Our Choice

### – Lesson Four: Obey God No Matter What

#### *Study of Daniel 6*

*Theme Verse:* “Even though Daniel was aware the king had signed the ordinance *into law*, he continued to do what he always did... and get down on his knees three times a day and pray to his God and praise Him.” (6:10 VOICE)

#### *Outline:*

- God Knows What I’m Going Through
- God Wants Me to Obey Him No Matter the Outcome
- God Doesn’t Need Me to Defend Myself
