





- Scissors & Twine
- Hot glue gun + Glue



Once you have your paper cut, place your dowel on one end.

Step-by-step Instructions



Wrap the the edge of your paper around the dowel just once .

Using a hot glue gun, glue the paper to itself right at the crease of your roll. Roll the dowel over the glue and hold in place while glue dries.





Add a dab of hot glue just inside the end of the rolled paper. Press paper onto glue to secure the paper to the dowel. **Repeat Steps 1-4 for the other end!**

Now that your dowels are secured to each end of the paper, carefully roll the paper around each roll so it curls nicely.
