GENERAL RULES (Subject to changes)

Review with campers before coming to camp.

1. Adult sponsors are basically responsible for the conduct of campers under their supervision.
2. **Modest dress** must be worn by campers at all times. Mid-thigh or longer shorts may be worn. Clothes such as tank tops, spaghetti strap and mid-riff tops should be left at home. No beer, tobacco, or non-Christian advertising. Swim suits may be worn only during swim time for your group. Shoes and cover garment (long T-shirt, etc.) must be worn while going to and from the pool area.
3. Campers and sponsors are not to leave the camp area without the knowledge of some member of the Superintendent's staff.
4. Campers will be responsible for any property which they may damage or destroy. Facilities must be left clean. Cabins have posted rules. **Cabins that are locked are NOT to be entered.**
5. Camp fees are payable upon arrival and are not refundable except by the owners of the campgrounds.
6. All campers (youth and adult) will be required to attend each worship and study period which is conducted for their age group.
7. Adult sponsors will be responsible for reverent behavior on the part of those under their care. Food and drinks will not be permitted in the worship and study periods.
8. Any additional regulations which the owners of the campgrounds normally require will be rigidly enforced by the officers of this encampment.
9. Each group must have an adult sponsor for both boys and girls unless other arrangements have been made with the superintendent and another sponsoring church. The age limit for children without an accompanying parent is 8 years old. Other arrangements must be made with a sponsoring church. Any child over age 3 must stay in a cabin with campers of the same sex.
10. Medical release forms will be **mandatory** for each camper. These are available with the registration info prior to coming to camp. Please have a form for every person in attendance.
11. **No energy drinks (Monster, etc.) allowed.**
12. **CAMP WILL BE LOCKED DOWN @ 11PM**

WHAT TO BRING

Bible, notebook, pen or pencil.
Your own bedding, sheets, pillow, blanket, etc., or sleeping bag. Towels, wash cloths. Include enough towels for swim times.
Enough clothing for four (4) days. Leave tank tops, spaghetti strap and mid-riff tops, alcohol, tobacco, and anti-Christian T-shirts at home.
Everyone should bring two (2) pairs of shoes.
MUST have tennis shoes for sport activities.
All your personal items such as toothbrush and paste, comb or brush, soap, etc. It would be a good idea to bring a light jacket too. A ball glove if you are going to play, maybe a game you could play in the cabin, etc. The camp provides a limited supply of games and equipment.
Spending money for concession stand...It will be open about three times each day.
Cell Phone use will be limited
Those listening to headphones – anyone can ask to hear what they are listening to.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Skateboards, roller blades, tobacco; non-Christian and/or illegal items, clothes, and advertisements.

Please be on time for all of our scheduled activities, this helps everyone.

Do not take anything that does not belong to you!

If you have a complaint, please take it to your sponsor, then if needed to the camp superintendent.

If anyone needs to receive medical assistance, please notify your sponsor immediately.
