## Day One—Sermon Application

In today's sermon, we learned that in the eyes of God our eternity is secure. **How does it make you feel to know that God promises to keep us for eternity?**

Read Ephesians 2:1-10. **Why do we need salvation? What does God do for us when we trust in Christ for salvation? What are we to do as a result of salvation?**

## Day Two—Worship Preparation

One of the songs we will be singing next Sunday is ***I Stand Amazed in the Presence***. Spend some time praying through the lyrics of this song.

He took my sins and my sorrows,

## Day Three—Sermon Anticipation

**Prayerfully read Romans 8:31-39.**

When we read verses 32-34 and realize that this event that happened 2,000 years ago, the text reaches our hearts and gives us hope. As you anticipate God's Word to you this next week, **spend some time dwelling upon these thoughts:**

***Jesus bore your sins on the cross.***

***God is for you not against you.***

***This Jesus, who loved us and gave Himself for us is alive and with us in every moment of our lives.***

***He is our hope when we feel defeated!***

Memorizing Scripture is extremely beneficial. Psalm 119:11 encourages us to hide God's Word in our heart to keep us from sinning against Him. **Beginning with Romans 8:37-39 and working backward through the chapter, memorize as much of Romans 8 as possible.**
