Day One—Sermon Application

In today's sermon, we learned that in the eyes of God our eternity is secure. **How** does it make you feel to know that God promises to keep us for eternity?

Read Ephesians 2:1-10. Why do we need salvation? What does God do for us when we trust in Christ for salvation? What are we to do as a result of salvation?

Day Two—Worship Preparation

One of the songs we will be singing next Sunday is *I Stand Amazed in the Presence*. Spend some time praying through the lyrics of this song.

He took my sins and my sorrows, He made them His very own; He bore the burden to Calv'ry, And suffered, and died alone. When with the ransomed in glory
His face I at last shall see,
'Twill be my joy through the ages
To sing of His love for me.

Day Three—Sermon Anticipation

Prayerfully read Romans 8:31-39.

When we read verses 32-34 and realize that this event that happened 2,000 years ago, the text reaches our hearts and gives us hope. As you anticipate God's Word to you this next week, **spend some time dwelling upon these thoughts**:

Jesus bore your sins on the cross.

God is for you not against you.

This Jesus, who loved us and gave Himself for us is alive and with us in every moment of our lives.

He is our hope when we feel defeated!

Memorizing Scripture is extremely beneficial. Psalm 119:11 encourages us to hide God's Word in our heart to keep us from sinning against Him. Beginning with Romans 8:37-39 and working backward through the chapter, memorize as much of Romans 8 as possible.
