## Day One—Sermon Application

Once God extended grace to the people of Nineveh, what was Jonah's reaction? What are some of the reasons you think he acted like that? How did Jonah feel about the Ninevites?

Read Luke 10:1-20. What was Jesus' purpose in sending out the 72? Were they successful in their mission? When they returned, what were they most excited about reporting to Jesus (vv. 17-19)? In verse 20, what did Jesus say ought to make them rejoice? How does that change your view of your salvation?

## **Day Two—Worship Preparation**

Next Sunday, we will be singing the song **Remind Me Who I Am**. Spend some time praying over these lyrics.

## Day Three—Sermon Anticipation

Read and meditate on Hebrews 1:1-2.

Sunday, we will be focusing on how God has spoken and how He speaks to us today.

- 1. He speaks through His creation. (Psalm 19:14)
- 2. He speaks to and through the Prophets (e.g. to Moses on Mt. Sinai or to Elijah in a still small voice). What other prophets did God speak to and through? What was His message to us?
- 3. He speaks by His Son (John 1:1).
- 4. He speaks through His Word. Think about journaling some of the things that God has spoken to you through His Word this week. What has God said to you?
