Over the past couple of months we have been learning how to answer questions that skeptics may ask about our faith in Jesus Christ. The Bible

tells us to be "prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you" (1 Pet 3:15).

What is the *hope* that is

in us? Paul wrote to the church at Corinth: "If in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied. But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead..." (1 Cor 15:19). And since Christ has been raised from the dead, we too have been raised in order that we might walk in newness of life (Rom 6). If our hope is in Christ and Christ is our hope, we are new creations (2 Cor 5:17)—"created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them" (Eph 2:9).

Hope changes everything! Unfortunately, there are countless thousands of people living today who have NO hope! Will we be the instrument that God will choose to use to offer them hope? God has created us in Christ Jesus to reconcile us to Himself and give us the ministry of reconciliation (2 Cor 5:18). It is our responsibility to carry this message to those who have no hope!
