## DAY ONE—SERMON APPLICATION

- **Has anyone ever told you that your communication came across in a way that you did not intend?** Communicating the necessary truth in a kind way is my responsibility—no one can do this for me—and if that truth is not communicated clearly then I need to improve my communication skills.
- No matter what we are communicating—whether the eternal truths about salvation or a simple “To Do” list—our message must be clear to everyone who will be listening. If you struggle with being a clear communicator, pray and ask God to help you grow in your ability to ‘make it clear.’ **Will you make your daily communication a matter of prayer?**

## DAY TWO—WORSHIP PREPARATION

Spend some time today dwelling upon the Father’s love for you and the sacrifice of His only Son on your behalf.
