

STEP 1: Stay away from controversies. (2 Timothy 2:23)

- ⇒ Read 1 Corinthians 3:1-3. What does Paul say about people who are jealous and quarrelsome?
- ⇒ Ask yourself, "Why do I feel the need to stir things up?"

STEP 2: Be able to teach. (2 Timothy 2:24)

- ⇒ Read Colossians 3:16. Paul instructs us to "let the word of Christ dwell" in us. This means that we should spend time studying and meditating on the Word of God.
- ⇒ Read chapters 2, 3 and 4 of 2 Timothy. Notice every time a form of the word "teach" is mentioned. Spend some time thinking about what it means to be able to teach.

STEP 3: Be willing to correct with gentleness. (2 Timothy 2:25a)

- ⇒ Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17 and 4:1-2. What is the purpose of Scripture?
- ⇒ In Ephesians 4:15, Paul instructs us to speak the truth in love. What changes do you need to make in your life to obey this instruction?

STEP 4: Be kind to everyone. (2 Timothy 2:24)

- ⇒ Read Ephesians 4:32. How does the Bible say we should interact with one another?
- ⇒ Ask yourself, "Do I give people the benefit of the doubt? Or do I always seem to presume the worst?"

STEP 5: Be forbearing without being resentful. (2 Timothy 2:24)

- ⇒ Read Ephesians 4:29-32. What does this passage say about patiently enduring evil treatment from others? How should we treat others?
- ⇒ Ask yourself, "Am I willing to treat people with kindness even when I know that they are treating me maliciously?"
