Pastor Wade preached from Revelation 3:7-13 on the letter to the church at Philadelphia. What did you hear in this message that helped you discover a spiritual truth for your life?

One of the additional passages that Pastor Wade focused on was Deuteronomy 7:9. Read that verse again. What comfort do you find in this verse? What warning is evident in the immediate context?

Now go to the previous chapter, Deuteronomy 6, and read verses 1-15. Be sure to pray for God to speak to you through His Word before you read (c.f. Psalm 119:18).

Notice that this passage is broken up into 3 to 4 paragraphs. Write down (or discuss) several observations from the following sections:

- Deuteronomy 6:1-3
- Deuteronomy 6:4-9
- Deuteronomy 6:10-15

\* Use the six investigative questions to help you—who, what, when, where, why and how.

Focusing in on Deuteronomy 6:4-9, what did you discover that you could apply to your personal life this week? What did you discover that you need to apply in your family?

What will you do? When will you do it?

Close your time together in prayer, asking God to help you keep the commitments that you have just made in response to this study.
