Developing Routine

Our church staff has been encouraging everyone to consider using being homebound as a catalyst for strengthening or implementing a daily Bible Reading and study plan. Over the next couple of weeks, I aim to provide some resources to make that possible. As I considered where to direct our study, I wanted to offer something practical for the diverse emotional responses to quarantine.

Exploring the Psalms



Week 1: Scripture

DAY 1
Reading Plan: Psalm 1 and Psalm 2
Challenge Plan: Psalm 19 and Psalm 106
Reflection Questions:

- What is significant about the tree and the stream? What do they represent?
- The righteous person's delight is in the law. What is the difference between an attitude of delight and duty in approaching the Bible?

DAY 2
Reading Plan: Psalm 119:1-40
Challenge Plan: Psalm 12, Psalm 25 and Psalm 36
Reflection Questions:

- In v. 15 the Psalmist asks God to "open [their] eyes;" what does this teach us about how we should approach studying scripture.

DAY 3
Reading Plan: Psalm 119:41-80
Challenge Plan: Psalm 27 and Psalm 128
Reflection Questions:

- Vv. 47 and 48 mentions "delight" and "meditation" on God's Word. Why does the Psalmist do each of these (hint v. 49)?

DAY 4
Reading Plan: Psalm 119:81-128
Challenge Plan: Psalm 42, Psalm 43 and Psalm 81
Reflection Questions:

- What is the relationship between understanding something and obeying something?
- How are obedience and compliance different?

DAY 5
Reading Plan: Psalm 119:129-176
Challenge Plan: Psalm 84, Psalm 101 and Psalm 112
Reflection Questions:

- In vv. 145-152, the psalmist is going through something difficult. How did their previous faithfulness prepare them for this time?
