Last week we began a journey exploring the book of Psalms as a daily Bible study...

As we continue this journey, find a rhythm that causes your attitude to become one of excitement and anticipation (like the psalmists we read from last week) as you open up the psalter each day. Personally, I grab my first cup of coffee and recline back on my wooden deck the same way I would if I had just dug out the box of notes and love letters that Michelle and I have saved from our days in high school together. Doing this sets the stage for my mind to be attentive to what I am getting ready to do and helps to defend against unnecessary distractions. Reading Plan: **Psalm 8**
Challenge Plan: **Psalm 41 and Psalm 68**
Reflection Questions:
• Have you ever wondered while staring at a starry sky, how God could care about your life? Do you feel important to God?

DAY 2
Reading Plan: **Psalm 22**
Challenge Plan: **Psalm 41 and Psalm 68**
Reflection Questions:
• On a 1-21 scale between faith and despair, where would you mark your spiritual life between these? Faith ←————→ Despair

DAY 3
Reading Plan: **Psalm 35**
Challenge Plan: **Psalm 34, Psalm 49 and Psalm 69**
Reflection Questions:
• Is there any injustice in your world that hurts you enough to pray against it? If there is none, what does that say about your concern for justice and compassion for others?

DAY 4
Reading Plan: **Psalm 109**
Challenge Plan: **Psalm 16, Psalm 97 and Psalm 102**
Reflection Questions:
• How does Psalm 109 compare with Jesus' attitude towards false persecution (Matthew 5:11, 12)?

DAY 5
Reading Plan: **Psalm 118**
Challenge Plan: **Psalm 48, Psalm 68 and Psalm 110**
Reflection Questions:
• What does the verse 14 in Psalm 118 mean? Is there a process to these two lines or is the writer just saying the same thing twice?
