• What is the reason for praising God in today's Psalms?

Reading Plan: **Psalms 93, 95, & 100**
Challenge Plan: **Psalms 145, 146, 147, & 148**
Reflection Questions:
• How can we know that "we are God's people" (consider the current sermon series through 1 John)?

DAY 5
Reading Plan: **Psalms 105**
Challenge Plan: **Psalms 111, 145, & 150**
Reflection Questions:
• How can we be sure of God's future faithfulness?
