We are concluding our series through the book of First John this morning. We hope that you have enjoyed this study, but we hope even more that you have come to a place in your spiritual life where you have assurance of your salvation!

Our next study will be an exposition of the book of Ruth. We're excited about this study because the book of Ruth "shows how God's people can experience his sovereignty, wisdom, and covenant kindness. These often come in hard circumstances and are expressed through the kindness of others" (www.esv.org).

The book of Ruth takes place during the time of the judges. As you may remember, this time period in

the lives of the children of Israel was a dark time when "everyone did what was right in his own eyes" (Judges 17:6; 21:25). This time is described in the NIV Study Bible as "a period of religious and moral degeneracy, national disunity and frequent foreign oppression."



In a time when it seemed that everyone was doing what they wanted without regard for God's instruction, the story of Ruth gives us a glimpse into the

lives of what seemed to be an insignificant family in Israel, that were later recognized as the great-grandparents of David, the King of Israel.
