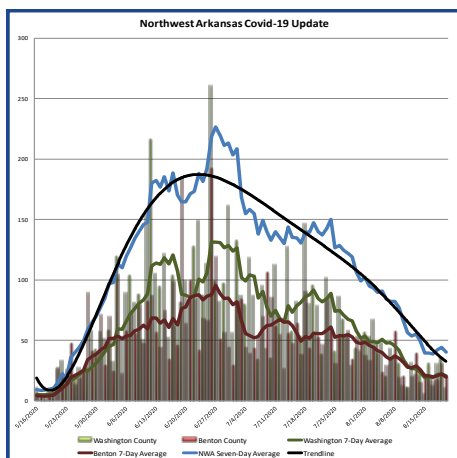

NORTHWEST ARKANSAS COVID-19 UPDATE

It's been almost two months since we hit our peak of new Coronavirus cases here in Northwest Arkansas. On June 27th, the seven-day rolling average of new cases in Benton and Washington counties was 227 per day. As of Friday, August 20th, that average has decreased to 40 new cases per day. This is great news for Northwest Arkansas!
