The Urgent Need for Unity

In a recent survey of churches in the United States, it was determined that 91% of those churches has dealt with some sort of divisive event within their church family during this time of pandemic. Can you imagine that? Ten out of eleven churches surveyed have had internal turmoil on top of the external pressures that have come from COVID-19.

The past ten months have brought with it frustrations and conflict unlike anything I have experienced so far in my 6+ years of ministry here. Why do I mention this to you today?

I believe that we are at a cross-roads in history. Life in the weeks and months to come will never be the same again. No matter what events the future may hold, I believe that life as followers of Jesus Christ will only become more and more difficult. How will we respond to these difficulties?

As I face difficulties in my own personal life, it often causes me to be irritable and easily frustrated. It seems to me that frustrations seem to multiply and reproduce. In this type of atmosphere, we must be especially careful that we do not allow our personal frustrations to bleed over into interpersonal conflict in the church.

Don't forget what Jesus said: "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."
