## Bible Reading: Luke 5:1-3

## Questions for Reflection:

Where is Jesus at this time? Where is the lake of Gennesaret?

Who is this Simon that owned the boat? Where was he and what was he doing when Jesus got into his boat?

Why did Jesus teach the crowd from the boat? Was He just trying to get away from the crowd or was there an analytical reason for His decision?

Jesus used what was available to Him to help communicate truth to these people. What could you use to help communicate truth to those around you?

## Bible Reading: Luke 5:3-5

## Questions for Reflection:

After Jesus finished teaching the crowd, what did He ask Simon to do?

Considering that Jesus grew up as the son of a carpenter, how much would Simon think Jesus knew about fishing?

What do we learn about Simon's relationship with Jesus by the way he addresses Him?

In your opinion, how would you describe Simon's physical and emotional state at this time? How would you have felt if you had worked all night but would not be paid for your labor?

Why did Simon do as Jesus told him?

## Bible Reading: Luke 5:6-11

## Questions for Reflection:

What happened when Simon did what Jesus told him?

Read verse 8 again. Why did Simon react this way after Jesus performed this miracle?

Who else was there to witness this? What do you think was going through their minds as they saw the haul of fish that was caught?

How does Jesus redefine the careers of these men? What did Jesus mean by what He said in verse 10?

How did the men respond to Jesus' instruction?
