CELEBRATING THE LORD'S SUPPER—TONIGHT

One of the most sacred times of worship that we have here at Temple Baptist is the observance of the Lord's Supper. We refer to this—and baptism—as the ordinances of the church. A church ordinance is a reenactment of the message of the gospel.

Some people refer to baptism and the Lord's Supper (aka communion) as sacraments. A sacrament, by definition, is considered a means of God's grace; but that is not what these sacred ceremonies are. They are a picture of God's grace, not a means to obtain His grace. So why do we observe this ordinance?

You may or may not realize it, but the reason for celebrating the Lord's Supper is

carved on the front of the table from which it is served. We are to do this in order to remember the sacrifice Jesus made in His death and resurrection. The bread is a memorial to the crucified body of Christ; and the "fruit of the vine" (aka grape juice) reminds us of His shed blood that is the atonement of sin for all who believe.

So, we want to invite all of our church members to come back this evening at 6:00 to experience this special time of worship. I would also like to encourage you to spend some time preparing your heart before you come. Ask God to search your heart and mind to see if there are any offensive or rebellious things in your life (Ps 139:23-24).
