PARK IN THE BACK... SIT IN THE FRONT... BY WADE ALLEN

Over the past nine years, I have leaned into the wisdom of Pastor Ron Fields on many occasions. His advice is always measured and always wise! One of the things I heard him say not long after my arrival in 2014 was this: "I always encouraged people to park in the back and sit in the front!"

I want to once again encourage you to take Pastor Ron's advice to park in the back and sit in the front.

When it's your first time to go to a new church, the last thing you want to do is to parade up to the front of the auditorium in front of everyone else, but if there are no seats available toward the back of the building, you have only two options: 1) march up to the front with everyone watching, or 2) escape to the parking lot while no one is looking.

I hope that you agree with me that neither one of these is a good option!

The same is true in the parking lot. If you pull into a church parking lot but cannot find a place to park, you are likely to leave and find a place with more available parking.

As we prepare for a full house next Sunday because of Easter, I want to ask you to put the needs of others before your own (Philippians 2:4). In fact, you might even consider moving closer to the front today... Just to see how it feels! As always, thanks for your willingness to do something new!
