This is the last week for EasyTithe. We are moving our online giving to the Church Center App.

If you have not signed up for it yet, then please find one of the sheets of paper in the foyer and follow those instructions. If you would like additional help, please find me or my wife (John or Laura) or one of the other pastors and we will walk you through downloading the app and the setting up your first gift.

As with all technology, there is a cost for the service. Giving from your bank through ACH is the lowest charge to the Church. One of the nice

things with this particular service is that it has an option available for church members to be able to cover that charge if they want to.

At this point, our plan is to turn off the old service at the end of April (this week) so we will not incur any additional charges with EasyTithe. All accounts that have recurring gifts set up in the old app will be cancelled. All your personal information will be cleared out of that system and there will not be anymore withdrawals from your account from EasyTithe.
