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QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

Read Luke 18:9-14. Who did Jesus tell this parable to? How does the Bible describe them?

The primary characters in this parable include a Pharisee and a tax collector. What do we know about Pharisees in general? What about tax collectors?

How would you characterize the Pharisee based upon the prayer that he prayed in verses 11-12?

The prayer of the tax collector was obviously very different from that of the Pharisee. How would you describe the differences in the heart, or disposition, of the tax collector compared with the Pharisee?

According to Jesus, whose prayer was answered? Why?

What is the root sin issue that lies below someone's self-exaltation? (consider verses 9 and 14)

What does it mean to humble yourself? What was the tax collector communicating with his words and his body language?
