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QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

In Luke 9:51; 13:22; and 17:11, the Bible tells us that Jesus was on His way somewhere. Where was He going?

Read Luke 18:35-38. What area was He approaching in this passage? Where was that in relation to His ultimate destination?

Who did Jesus encounter along the way?

When the blind man heard a crowd of people passing by, he inquired about what was going on. Who did the crowd say was passing by that way? Be specific!

By what name, or designation, did the blind man refer to Jesus?

For Jews of that time period, who was “Son of David” from their interpretation of Scripture? (cf. 2 Samuel 7:16)

Later in Luke 21:15, how did Jesus’ enemies react when they heard crowds of people referring to Jesus as the “Son of David”?

What can we discern about the blind man based on the name he used to cry out to Jesus when he asked for mercy?

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

Read Luke 18:35-38 again. Who was crying out to Jesus as He was passing nearby?

What did Jesus do when He heard the man crying out to Him?

What did the blind man request of Jesus?

According to what Jesus said, why was the blind man healed?

What evidence do we see that this was not only a physical healing, but also a spiritual healing?

How did the crowd respond to this miracle? When we see the hand of God at work, how do we *usually* respond? How *should* we respond?
